

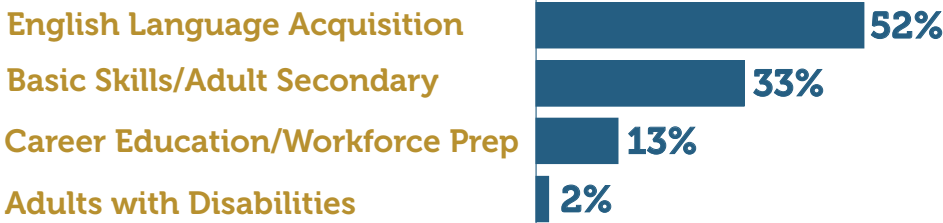

Enrollment by Program Area

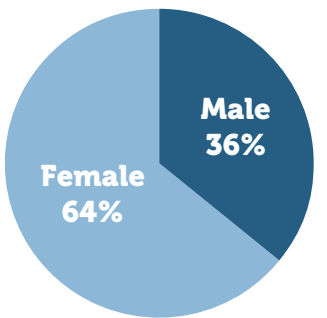

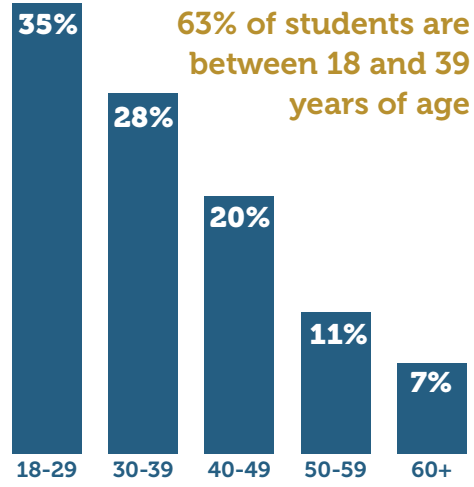
